Hotel Dog Policies

The Lancaster Host Resort and the Old English Sheepdog Club of American welcomes you and your dog. These rules have been established for the safety of everyone and the preservation of the hotel. When these rules are followed, the hotel atmosphere is greatly enhanced by the presence of your dogs and we sincerely look forward to hosting your shows and events.

■ Two (2) dogs maximum per room. Dogs must be crated in guestrooms at all times, especially when owners are not in the room. NO EXCEPTIONS. Plastic is required under all crates in the rooms. This is to be provided by the dog clubs or owners. This is for the safety of the hotel personnel, the hotel property and the dogs. You are responsible for any damages.

■ For those of you traveling with more than 2 dogs, OESCA is providing overnight security from 10:00 pm - 6:00 am in the expo center. If you are leaving a dog overnight you will be issued a pass and a crate tag for emergency contact. Please come to the committee table to get your crate tags and pass.

- There will be a \$75.00 refundable deposit. Deposit will be refunded after a house keeping supervisor has checked the room on guest's departure. Guests will be charged for any additional cleaning or damage.
- NO dogs are to be bathed or groomed in the rooms at any time. A bathing and grooming area has been set up in the hotel. A second dog wash area is located next to the Expo Center at the white barn. Guests must provide their own soap and towels.
- Owners must pick up outdoor exercise areas after use by their dogs. Scoopers or (preferably) plastic baggies need to be deposited in designate trash cans only. Use designated areas to exercise your dogs.
- Dogs must be cleaned up after. Please contact the hotel's front desk if you need to clean up inside the hotel or your room. Clean up supplies will be furnished to you. You will be responsible for any additional cleaning charges, if applicable.
- NO dog "marking" permitted. Please be constantly aware of the natural territorial instincts and do not permit your dog to "mark" (urinate on) walls, furniture, decor, or other inappropriate indoor objects or furnishings. If you do have an accident, please ask the front desk for assistance.
- No dogs are permitted in the restrooms, restaurant or other common areas.. Observe and Obey Signs - The Golf course is off-limits to dogs. Please respect posted signs and staff directions regarding designated exercise areas.
- Maid service is required each day. There are no exceptions!
- These policies and fees are subject to change without notice.
