### **Award of Merit**

**OESCA:** At the Judge's Discretion 10 special rosettes may be awarded to individual specimens in intersex competition for their merit. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for this award as their extraordinary merit has already been recognized.

**WROESC:** At the Judge's Discretion 5 special rosettes may be awarded to individual specimens in intersex competition for their merit. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for this award as their extraordinary merit has already been recognized.

Note: Effective for all shows held on or after June 1, 1980, dogs that according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)**

**Veteran Dog Class** for dogs seven (7) years of age and over. The winner of the Veteran Dog Class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

**Veteran Bitch Class** for bitches seven (7) years of age and over. The winner of the Veteran Bitch Class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

**Best Veteran** The winner of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Class are eligible.

**Best Puppy** Winners of the Puppy classes 6 months thru 12 month classes are eligible.

**Best Bred-By** Winners of the Bred-By classes are eligible.

Sweepstakes is open to Old English Sheepdogs who on the day of the sweepstakes will be 6 mos. of age and under 18 mos. of age. Professional handlers may handle only their own dogs. Each dog or bitch must be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty. ENTRY FEE IS \$28.00.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG  
ENTRIES**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**BRACE CLASS:** Two dogs of identical ownership. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars **MUST** be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising **EACH BRACE** must be so designated. "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS**- For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** -For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS**- For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

## **AGILITY CLASSES**

### **Standard Classes**

**Novice Agility Class** - The Novice Agility class is divided into Divisions A & B. Handlers of all levels, judges and dogs with AKC agility titles all compete in the same class. This is the entry-level class for dogs starting in the Preferred program even if they have upper level agility titles. There is no grandfathering into the Preferred class. **Open Agility Class** - In this class, dogs must have obtained the Novice Agility title (NA) but not yet have obtained a qualifying score in the Agility Excellent class.

**Open Agility Preferred Class** - In this class, dogs must have obtained the Novice Agility Preferred title (NAP) but not yet have obtained a qualifying score in the Agility Excellent Preferred class.

**Agility Excellent Class** - The Agility Excellent class is divided into Divisions A & B. In Division A, dogs must have achieved the Open Agility title (OA), but not yet have obtained the Agility Excellent title (AX). In Division B dogs must that have achieved the Agility Excellent title (AX). Dogs must move to Division B as soon as they complete the AX title.

**Agility Excellent Preferred Class**- The Agility Excellent Preferred class is divided into Divisions A & B. In Division A, dogs must have achieved the Open Agility Preferred title (OAP), but not yet have obtained a qualifying score in the Agility Excellent Preferred class. In Division B, dogs must have achieved the Agility Excellent Preferred title (AXP). Dogs must move to Division B as soon as they complete the AXP title.

### **Jumpers With Weaves Classes (JWW)**

**Novice JWW Class** - The Novice JWW class is divided into Divisions A & B. Division A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title, and Division B is for dogs that have acquired an AKC agility title(s), persons that have handled a dog to an AKC agility title and for agility judges.

**Novice JWW Preferred Class** - The Novice JWW Preferred class is not divided in to Divisions A & B. Handlers of all levels, judges and dogs with AKC agility titles all compete in the same class. This is the entry-level class for dogs starting in the Preferred JWW program even if they have upper level agility titles. There is no grandfathering into the Preferred class.

**Open JWW Class** - In this class, dogs must have obtained the Novice JWW title (NAJ), but not yet have obtained a qualifying score in the Excellent A JWW class.

**Open JWW Preferred Class** - In this class, dogs must have obtained the Novice JWW Preferred title (NJP), but not yet have obtained a qualifying score in the Excellent JWW Preferred class.

**Excellent JWW Class** - The Excellent JWW class is divided into Divisions A & B. Division A is for dogs that have achieved the Open Agility JWW title (OAJ), but not yet have obtained the Agility Excellent JWW title (AXJ). Division B is for dogs that have achieved the Agility Excellent JWW title (AXJ). Dogs must move to Division B as soon as they complete the AXJ title.

**Excellent JWW Preferred Class**- The Excellent JWW Preferred class is divided into Divisions A & B. In Division A, dogs must have achieved the Open JWW Preferred title (OJP), but not yet have obtained the Excellent JWW Preferred title (AJP). In Division B, dogs must have achieved the Excellent JWW Preferred title (AJP). Dogs must move to Division B as soon as they complete the AJP title.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List .A \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and a \$.50 RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule. Chapter 11, Section 2).

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS** Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Event Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. **Obstacles**

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.

**Height Card Information**

As you know, AKC requires that all dogs have a height card or they must be measured at the show by the judge of record. If you have a permanent or temporary height card, please include a photocopy of the card with your entry. If you do not have a height card on file, you will need to check in at the trial site. You must have a height card or be measured BEFORE you can run your dog.

**Jump Height Card Information**

Effective September 1, 2006

For dogs under two (2) years of age that have been officially measured, the owner/handler must present this yellow form as a temporary AKC Agility Jump Height Card at check-in. All dogs two (2) years of age or older will be required to receive two (2) measurements for a permanent AKC Agility Jump Height Card to be issued. A third measurement will be used as a tie breaker (between jump heights) if necessary. A permanent AKC Agility Jump Height Card will not be issued until the second (or if necessary the third) measurement is officially recorded, with the exception of dogs measuring over 22" whose owner may request the issuance of a permanent AKC Agility Jump Height Card with one measurement.

Regular Classes Preferred Classes

16 Inches:..... 12 Inches: .....For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.

## Agility Regulations

Bitches in Season will not be admitted to the Trial. Any Exhibitor with a bitch entered which is in season on the Trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5.00 upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary not later than 7:00AM on the day of the Trial.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

This trial is held outdoors on grass. Ring size is 100' x 100'.

By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

## Dogs Eligible to Enter

This Agility Trial is limited to Old English Sheepdogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or an AKC ILP number. Old English Sheepdogs with an acceptable foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Sec. 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and any communicable diseases. They should have all appropriate vaccinations.

## Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class. Contact familiarization for all novice classes will not be offered at this event.

## Move Ups

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing or email to the Trial Secretary and received no later than Wed., September 19, 2007 at 6PM.

**ELIGIBILITY:** *To be eligible for this competition, an Old English Sheepdog must participate in at least two of the three performance events (AKC obedience, rally and agility) offered at the 2007 OESCA National Specialty . The dog must be pre-entered in this event (see entry form).*

**ENTRY INFORMATION:** *The entry fee is \$5.00. The deadline for entry is September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2007 and the entry form should be mailed to the Show Secretary*

*(see entry form for address).*

**GENERAL RULES:**

- 1) The OES need not be handled by the same person in all events.
- 2) The OES needs a qualifying score\* (*as defined below*) in at least two performance events.
- 3) Only the highest qualifying score in each event will be counted.
- 4) The OES that obtains the highest point total (out of a possible 300 points) will win the award.

*\* For the purpose of this competition, "qualifying score" means any score of 170 or higher in obedience in any of the regular or non-regular obedience classes offered, with the exception of Brace. In rally and agility, standard AKC requirements for earning a qualifying score apply at all levels.*

**SCORING:**

**Obedience (max 100 points):**

*Both regular and non-regular classes will count towards this competition, with the exception of Brace. Only scores of 170 points or higher will count.*

Standard Classes (preferred or regular): total score out of 100

JWW (preferred or regular) : total score out of 100

FAST (preferred or regular) : total score out of 100
