Motor Home Overnight Reserved Parking

Going South on First St. (Hwy 113), turn left on E. Chestnut, at north edge of Fairgrounds. Go to the gate at the rear of the Fairgrounds.

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE SELF-CONTAINED. No discharge of waste/gray water on the grounds.

The overnight and day of show parking is a privilege extended by the Dixon May Fairgrounds and SVDF. SVDF reserves the right to withdraw this privilege from any person(s) who abuses this privilege or who uses abusive language. There will be no moving from assigned spaces nor trading of spaces without approval of the parking chairperson. **ALL PARKING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK**, show giving club assumes no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicles, its contents or dogs. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expense with no prior notification. No visitors will be allowed to drive their cars into the overnight reserved parking. They must walk. Please send a self-addressed stamped envelope or NO advance confirmation will be mailed.

Rigs longer than the stated length on reservation form will be parked at the rear of the parking area, at committee convenience.

SHOW REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.

Telegraph. Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Declination of Entries. The Old English Sheepdog Club of America may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Old English Sheepdog Club of America or any official thereof.

All Entry Fees are to be made payable to the **Old English Sheepdog Club of America (OESCA)** and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, 211 Wainwright Ct, Sacramento, CA 95838-2941. **FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For VISA/MasterCard and American Express cardholders **ONLY**. You must include the front and back of the entry form. A \$3.00 charge will be added for each dog, each day. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number and expiration date and signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number (916) 923-6383. This is for facsimile machine **ONLY**. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in this show. Proof of transmission is not proof of a receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4). **Merchant name for VISA/Mastercard and American Express will be under Judy Wilson, Show Secretary.**

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show will be Open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM each day.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

PLEASE NOTE:

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

(Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules states that neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Awards of Merit - After awarding Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, the Judge may select, at her discretion, recall into the ring up to ten dogs/bitches to receive Judges' Select Rosettes. These Rosettes are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

Best in Puppy Classes - The First place puppy of each of the four Puppy Classes (6-9 & 9-12 only) are eligible to compete for this award.

Best in Bred By Exhibitor Classes - The First place winner of each of the two Bred By Exhibitor Classes are eligible to compete for this award.

Best in Veteran Classes - The First place winner of each of the six Veteran Classes are eligible to compete for this award.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his get. As the decision of the judge in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged First in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not be the owner of the produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with her produce. As the decision of the judge in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged First in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

(Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.")

Brace Class - For two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owners and both dogs must be entered in another class.

THE FOLLOWING TROPHIES ARE OPEN TO DOGS OWNED OR CO-OWNED BY MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THE OLD ENGLISH SHEEPDOG CLUB OF AMERICA ONLY.

All trophies listed as perpetual trophies have been in competition prior to September 9, 1952, and cannot be won outright. Trophies which may be retired through multiple wins are so listed, along with the conditions for their retirement. All perpetual and multiple win trophies must be returned to the Secretary of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America immediately after awards have been presented and pictures taken. After certification by an authorized official of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America that the conditions for the retirement of a multiple win trophy have been met, said trophy shall be returned to the permanent possession of the certified winner. A certificate shall be awarded to the winners of all perpetual and multiple win trophies.

BEST OF BREED -- The Old English Sheepdog Club of America offers as a perpetual trophy the Club's Challenge Cup (Sterling Silver Punch Bowl) for Best of Breed. The Cup is offered for competition at all Specialty Shows of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America.

BEST OF BREED -- The Old English Sheepdog Club of America offers a club sterling silver demitasse spoon for Best of Breed. A total of eight or more dogs of different ownership must compete. (Husband and wife shall count as one owner).

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST OF BREED -- Mr. & Mrs. Louis Baer offer as a multiple win trophy the Ch. Bonnie Blue of Saltbox Memorial Trophy (SP Dublin Bowl) through the Old English Sheepdog Club of America at its Specialty Show for the Best of Opposite Sex to the Best of Breed. This trophy is offered for permanent possession after being won three times by the same owners, not necessarily with the same dog.

BEST OF WINNERS -- Tenacre Kennels offers as a perpetual trophy the Tenacre Kennels Trophy (Sterling Silver Sheepdog Statue on Pedestal) for the Best of Winners. The trophy is offered at all Specialty Shows of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America.

WINNERS DOG -- The Midlands Old English Sheepdog Club of England offers as a multiple win trophy the Midlands Old English Sheepdog Club Trophy (cut crystal decanter with two glasses). For permanent possession it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily at consecutive shows.

WINNERS BITCH -- Mr. & Mrs. Jack Lesslie offer as a multiple win trophy the Ch. Fezziwig Bonny Blue Flag Memorial Trophy (SP Wine Cooler) through the Old English Sheepdog Club of America at its Specialty Shows. This trophy is offered for permanent possession after being won three times by the same owners, not necessarily with the same bitch

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN REGULAR CLASSES -- Ann James Freeland offers as a multiple win trophy the Caj Haakansson Bred-By Exhibitor Memorial Trophy (silver chased bowl). This trophy is awarded to the Best Bred-By Exhibitor Dog or Bitch from the regular classes at the annual National Specialty Show of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America. For permanent possession it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily at consecutive shows.

FIRST IN AMERICAN-BRED DOG CLASS -- The Old English Sheepdog Club of America offers as a perpetual trophy the Robinson Hitchcock Memorial Trophy (Sterling Silver Bowl) for first in the American-Bred Dog Class. The trophy is offered for competition at all Specialty Shows of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America. To be awarded, three or more dogs must compete.

FIRST IN NOVICE BITCH CLASS -- Tenacre Kennels offers as a multiple win trophy the Tenacre Kennels Trophy (Sterling Silver Tray) for the Best Bitch in the Novice Class at the Specialty Show of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America. To be awarded two or more bitches must compete. This trophy is offered for permanent possession after being won five times.

FIRST IN AMERICAN-BRED BITCH CLASS -- Willinez Weather Kennels offers as a perpetual trophy the Reginald F. Mayhew Memorial Trophy (Sterling Silver Cup) for the first in the American-Bred Bitch Class. The trophy is offered for competition at all Specialty Shows of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America. To be awarded, three or more bitches must compete.

BEST VETERAN -- Jim & Grace Caplan offer the CH Canterbury's Critic's Choice Memorial Trophy (silver-plated wine cooler) to be awarded to the Best Veteran Dog or Bitch from the veteran classes at the annual National Specialty Show of the Old English Sheepdog Club of America. Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused under the Dog Show Rules for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.
