

## AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsman-ship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

"Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated – "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

**TEAM CLASS:** Four dogs of identical ownership. The dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Team Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. - If a dog qualifies in both Utility B and Open B, the highest score will apply, with an additional 5 points awarded for the additional qualifying score.
- The dog that wins High In Trial will be awarded an additional 5 points
- The dog that wins High Combined will be awarded an additional 5 points

**RALLY:**

Rally Excellent: total score plus 10 points

Rally Advanced: total score plus 5 points

Rally Novice: total score

- If a dog is competing in both Advanced B and Excellent B, the highest score will apply, with an extra 5 points awarded for additional qualifying score.

**AGILITY:**

Only highest qualifying score will be counted.

Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST (preferred or regular): total score out of 100 plus 10 points

Open Standard, JWW and FAST (preferred or regular) : total score out of 100 plus 5 points

Novice Standard, JWW and FAST (preferred or regular) : total score out of 100

- A dog that qualifies in 2 out of the 3 classes will be awarded an additional 5 points.
- A dog that qualifies in 3 out of the 3 classes offered will be awarded an additional 10 points.
- High in Trial winner will be awarded an additional 5 points

**\*Qualifying scores defined:**

For the purpose of this competition, "qualifying score" means any score of 170 or higher in obedience in any of the regular or non-regular obedience classes offered, with the exception of Brace, when offered. In rally a qualifying score is a score of 70 points or higher. In agility, standard AKC requirements for earning a qualifying score apply at all levels.

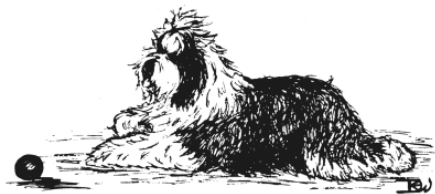
